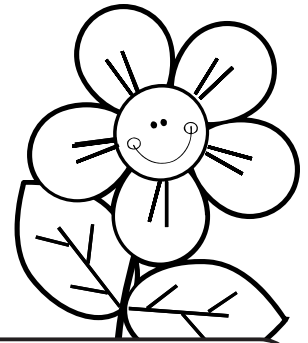

- reading and rhyming together!

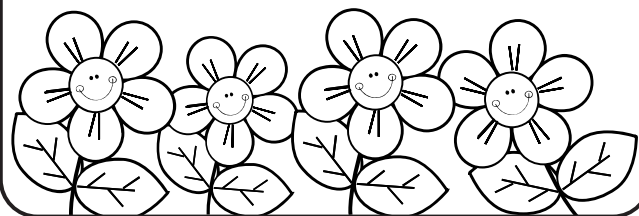
Special Song of the Month
